DEFINITION OF HIGHER EDUCATION (HE) APPRENTICESHIP



- Learning alternates between a workplace and an education centre
- Mentoring is a strong aspect preserved by the employer and the HEI
- The programme is part of a formal or continuing education training
- Successful learners receive a recognised certificate
- The training involves signing a contract or formal agreement by the student (apprentice), the employer and the HEI
- The apprentices receive remuneration in the form of wage or similar
